Biography (*abridged version*)

Stephan Scherpe gained his first experience as a singer in the Cathedral Choir of his home town, Merseburg.

After having graduated from the 'Hochschule für Musik und Theater' Leipzig with Berthold Schmid he quickly established himself as a busy singer predominantly in concert and oratorio with a repertoire ranging from SCHÜTZ to DUPRÉ. He has a special interest in the music by J. S. BACH and F. MENDELSSOHN BARTHOLDY which also includes other works from the 19th century, especially German Lied.

Stephan appears at distinguished music festivals throughout Germany as well as in Switzerland, the Netherlands, Belgium, Denmark, Italy, Monaco, Austria, France, Japan and in the USA.

He works with well known ensembles like *La petite bande*, *Stiftsbarock Stuttgart*, *Freiburg Baroque Orchestra*, *Gewandhausorchester Leipzig*, *Virtuosi Saxoniae* and *St. Thomas Choir Leipzig*.
